Senator Fletcher Wants Government to Inspect 'Pure Havanas' and Label 'Eure'

Washington, June 1.—A bill to protect the cigar smokers of the United States from the sale of adulterated and unwholesome cigars, and to secure the Federal revenue from the importation of Cuban tobacco, was introduced in the Senate today by Senator Fletcher of Florida. The bill provides for an inspection of the cigars imported into the United States and for the labeling of the same with the word "Eure" if they are found to be pure Havana cigars. The bill also provides for the seizure of adulterated cigars and for the imposition of a fine on the manufacturer of such cigars.

Senator Fletcher said that the bill was introduced in the Senate today because of the fact that the cigar industry in the United States has been suffering from the sale of adulterated and unwholesome cigars. 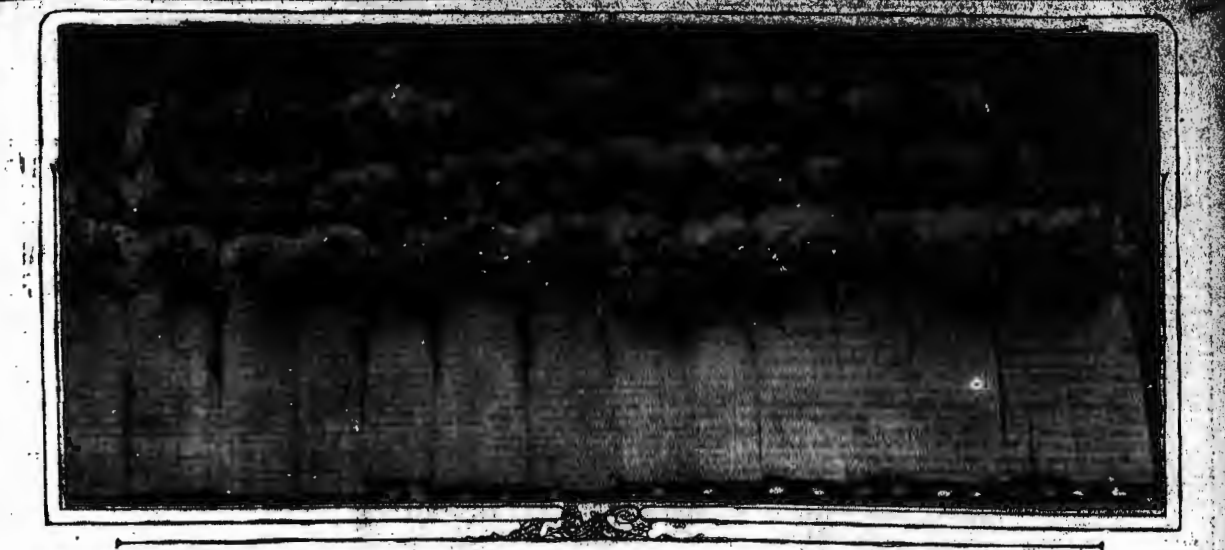
