WASHINGTON, July 31.—The administration is taking steps to be prepared for the worst in connection with the Mexican situation. The chief of the military resources of the government is made up to the possibility of a sudden change in the situation. A report received today from Acting Secretary of War Woodrow Wilson is to the effect that a request for three days of military supplies for the army at Mexico, during the month of August, has been received. When he replies from Mr. Roosevelt, it will be in line with the general policy of preparedness of the administration. The department will be advised of the results of the request, provided they are not needed at that time for use in Mexico.
