Portion of the affidavit made by Lemmie Quinn for Solicitor

Dorsey as follows:-

"The doors that lead up to the back stairs, after work hours are locked, but this door at the back of my department, the lock had been broken off and we placed a bar across it. The idea of that was to keep employees from the fourth floor going down from that department and ringing out and getting their money before it was ready. Customarily it was closed. That was the purpose. There is no exit from the office floor to the street floor, except the ~~front~~ front, there is a stairway leading from the office floor to the floor above. The back stairway is ordinarily closed with that door, which makes it impossible for anybody to come from the upstairs down to the office floor. A man on the office floor could lift the bar and walk out, but I should not think that a man could come down to the office floor from above at all....

I went uptown when I left home between 12 and 12:20. I got to the pool room about 12:30..... He (Frank) said he didn't know that he would mention it, but he would mention it to his lawyers and see if they thought it was favorable to mention it. That must have been Wednesday of last week."
