Negro Still On Stand In Phagan Murder Case

Atlanta, Ga., July 29.—When the trial of Leo M. Frank, charged with the murder of 14-year-old Mary Phagan, was resumed here before Judge L. S. Roank today Newt Lee, negro watchman at the pencil factory, where the girl's body was found, was again placed on the stand by the State.

Lee insisted that he knew nothing of the murder or the presence of the girl's body in the basement of the factory until he found it on the

morning of April 27.

Counsel for the defense sought to question Lee regarding certain notes written upon scraps of paper and found in the basement near the spot where the girl's body was discovered. The negro said he knew nothing about the notes.
