

LABOR CHIEFS DOOMED TO SERVE IN THE PEN

U. S. Supreme Court Rejects Pleas of Men Convicted in Dynamite Case.

Washington, March 9.—The final chapter in the iron workers' campaign to demand "open shops" with dynamite and nitroglycerin was written today by the supreme court in refusing to review a century-old sentence imposed on Frank M. Ryan, president of the International Association of Bridge and Structural Iron Workers and twenty-three of the association's members. The court, by a majority of five, refused to grant a writ of habeas corpus to Ryan and his associates, who had been sentenced to the United States penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kan., for their part in the explosion at the Los Angeles Times building in 1910.

Longest sentence for Ryan. The supreme court, in a review, Ryan was sentenced to the penitentiary for a term of ten years, and the other twenty-three men were sentenced to terms of from one to five years.

Justice A. C. McLean, of San Francisco, a vice president of the International Association of Bridge and Structural Iron Workers, was the only one of the twenty-three men who had been sentenced to the penitentiary. Justice McLean, in his opinion, said that the sentence imposed on Ryan and his associates was "not excessive" and that the court should not interfere with the judgment of the lower court.
