TOWNS LOCATED ON NORTH SEA.

The towns of Yarmouth, Sandringham, Kings' Lynn and Cromer are in the province of East Angles, about the North Sea about 140 miles north of London.

FOR BETTER SCHOOLS STUDENTS MAKE PLEA

Tell Rotarians They Are Unable to Study Properly in Present Buildings.

The imperative need of better high school facilities was forcibly presented to the Atlanta Rotarians, at their meeting and luncheon at the Windsor hotel Tuesday afternoon, by three students of the Boys' High school.

Richard W. Couris, Jr., Francis Spears and Walter P. Binn, agreed that school buildings were in a deplorable condition, and that something had to be done at once if the honor and title of the city were to be given an education under conditions that were "decent, respectable and adequate to the demands that were being made upon them."

President Albert B. Adams presided over the meeting when the ordinary business was conducted, and Vice President Frank O. Foster took the chair when the schools were under discussion.

Mrs. Robert Foreman and Mrs. Albert B. Adams were introduced as two lady Rotarians who were representing a committee which is selling land pencils for the benefit of the crippled children of the city. The Rotarians present promised to help the work.

High School Boys Speak.

President Adams announced that the special matter to be acted upon was the movement for better high schools for Atlanta, and he turned the meeting over to Vice President Foster, who stated that the present boys and girls high school buildings were a disgrace to the city.

"Atlanta," he said, "had fine office buildings, a costly courthouse, a good city hall, but no building for the high schools that is fit for the education of our young people."

Richard W. Couris, Jr., the first speaker from the Boys' High school, declared that he doubted if very many business men of Atlanta knew where the Boys' High school was located. He said that the public streets were the campus where the lives of the boys were daily in danger, that the noise from passing vehicles made such a din that pupils and teachers had to scream at each other to be heard; that 400 boys were crowded into a lot of small and poorly ventilated rooms.

"We do our best," he stated, "but what can be expected of boys under such conditions? Our curriculum has been cut up into classrooms with only a pen is left in the center, in which the boys try to hold debates. The building was erected years ago, when the attendance was not more than one-third of what it is at present. We not only have no chance to do good in the classrooms, but we have to go to Piedmont park when we wish to take healthy outdoor exercises. All of this causes the boys to lose interest and pride in their school, which can only operate against the proper spirit of education."

Condition of the Building.

The next high school speaker was Francis Spears. He said there were fifteen classrooms, of which one-third were unventilated. There were two small, poorly ventilated and poorly heated. One room was forced to burn lights all day, so the boys could see how to read. All of the departments lack adequate equipment. There are no study hall, no lockers and no bicycle room. A library and a lunch room are needed. He said the building as a whole was a fire trap and unfit from every standpoint for school purposes.

The third speaker, Walter P. Binn, said that a campus and an assembly hall were imperative needs. He then proceeded to furnish the Rotarians with the following statistics of the school, which was heard with considerable interest.

Louisville, Ky., is now building a \$250,000 school for boys in addition to spending \$111,000 for lot and equipment.

New Orleans last year completed a modern and up-to-date high school building at a cost of \$400,000. This handsome building has all the modern conveniences and is fit in every way to meet the needs of a large city school.

Birmingham has a high school building that cost nearly \$200,000. This building is not adequate to the needs of the city but is far beyond anything Atlanta has.

Mobile has just spent \$60,000 remodeling her high school building.

Richmond, Va., has just completed a high school building that cost \$400,000.

Given a Vote of Thanks.

When the speakers concluded a vote of thanks was given them. The Rotarians present, was called on. He paid a high tribute to the youthful speakers for their clear and forcible presentation of the high school situation. He said the time was not sufficient to discuss such an important question.

There is enough in the high school situation," he said, "to cause an outburst of indignation that could not find expression in a day's solid column."

He said that while the county had spent \$1,250,000 for a female in which to try criminals, the city could not find as much as a few thousand for a high school home for our boys and girls. He concluded by saying that there was no body of men in the city more capable of taking hold of the situation than the Rotarians.

On motion of Henry W. Grady the Rotarians enthusiastically and unanimously approved the movement for better high school facilities, and called upon the city to act accordingly.
