CUT THE STRING

The action of the house in increasing the school fund \$50,000 a year for two years looks like a sop to conscience, out-raged by the spectacle of this horde of

raged by the spectacle of this horde of hard-worked and small-salaried country school teachers unpaid for seven months. But of course the house knows that this "increase" is not going even to touch the problem. Instead of lightening the burden of the country school teacher and the schools it is noise to INCREASE THE BURDEN.

Why? Recause the apparent beneficience is a gift with a string tied to it. That string is the stubborn fact that not only is no provision made for the \$50.000 increase, but that no provision is made for the prompt payment of the \$25.000 which now composes the school fund. The school teachers must now wait until the last collection of taxes. In December 6 each year, lection of taxes, in December of each year, for their money. Does an increased appro-priation bring them one week nearer a just

pay day? It does not.

All the increase does is to add to the amount for which they must wait for from ten to twelve months. All it does is to add to the amount they now shylock in order to live at all.

The house, which is able individually and in leadership, has overlooked this fact. It has been jed away by its sympathy and its impute. But it has a ver field to lay the

impulse. But it has as yet failed to lay the ax at the root of the trouble. Until some provision is made whereby the teachers are provision is made whereby the teachers are paid as their pay comes due, instead of waiting indefinitely for it, every penny added to the appropriation will be simply piling on the misery and increasing the injustice and shame of the state.

It is THE COUNTRY SCHOOL TEACH-

ER, NOT THE CITY SCHOOL TEACHER, who is affected. The city school teachers are well paid, relatively speaking, and above all, they are promptly paid. It is the women who wear out health and strength and youth educating the children of the farmers who must put up, first, with pay less than a day laborer's, and next, with having to whistle for that pay until a tremendously wealthy commonwealth finds some wax to nay it. ER, NOT THE CITY SCHOOL TEACHER some way to pay it.

Cut the string to the gift! And the only way to cut it is to solve the problem that has been dishonoring Georgia for four decades by providing for prompt pay to the country school teacher.

Hand in hand with that task goes such tax equalization as will provide funds for school and other increases instead of forc-ing the state government to pile up a deficit which is now nearly three-quarters of a million dollars. It is easy enough to appro-priate money. But under our wretched revenue system there is no way whatever meet any increases without borrowing for meet any increases without borrowing from the future. 
