The following is a decision by Chief Justice Simmons, in 113 Georgia. He says:

"If the State relies upon circumstantial evidence, nat evidence must be so strong as to exclude every other hypothesis save that of the guilt of the accused.

IT MUST BE INCONSISTENT WITH HIS INNOCENCE. This rule must NOT be relaxed.

"When a heinous crime is committed in a com-munity, and the people are greatly shocked thereby, it is natural for them to catch at any little circumstance to throw suspicion upon SOME person, and to conclude from this or that circumstance that he is the guilty

party.
