CINCINNATI, O., May 17.—The refusal of Governor Cox to send troops today to control the strike of the employees of the Cincinnati Traction Company, after spectacular riots in the early part of the day had inundated Mayor Stuart with requests for military aid, was followed today by the filing of a petition by the city of Cincinnati for a receiver for the company.

Rioting was almost continuous today from the time the companies attempted to operate cars until they withdrew all cars from the streets at noon. Little later in the morning police officers were ordered to clear the streets of the rioters.

Mayor Stuart asked Governor Cox for troops after the riot at Fourth and Broadway streets today. He requested that the governor send troops to Cincinnati to help control the rioting.

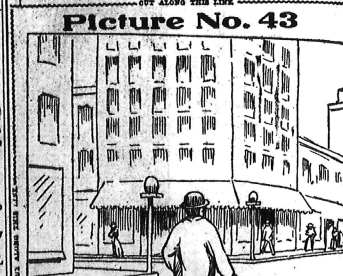
