


GEORGIA BOOSTED AS STATE FOR POULTRY

Government Expert Says This Is World's Finest Section for Raising Chickens

With her long summers and short, mild winters, Georgia is the finest country in the world for raising chickens, and poultry raisers here are busy at work, beginning October 1 and lay through the winter, according to Harry L. Lammon, state poultry extension worker in the bureau of animal industry of the United States department of agriculture, who has charge of all poultry authorities in the country.

Mr. Lammon spent Friday in Atlanta, and Saturday morning was on Peachtree street and conferring with D. J. Taylor, a special agent of the poultry extension, and with Dr. W. E. Taylor, a farm college at Athens to co-operate with the college in organizing boys and girls in the poultry business.

Mr. Lammon is making a tour of the southern states to see that agents in all the states are doing their best to insure a great and growing interest in poultry throughout this part of the country.

"I am informed that poultry raising has made great strides in Georgia during the past year," said Mr. Lammon, who said Friday to The Journal, "and I have no doubt that the Journal's poultry column is read by many persons, who, in a recognized authority on this subject, has had much to do with the development of the interest in the state." I understand there are hundreds of city poultry raisers in Atlanta with the same idea in mind, and these men could use their yards to no better advantage both for pleasure and profit.

Mr. Lammon stated that he would like for all persons interested in the business to make use of the free use of his department at Washington for information and advice. Mr. D. J. Taylor and Dr. W. E. Taylor, the agent at Athens will answer all inquiries concerning poultry which are addressed to him in care of the state farm college.
