





#### Good Roads and Population.

Here are some remarkably interesting figures, recently gathered by the United States office of puboads, showing the effect of highway improve on a community's population and develop ment. In twenty-five counties, taken at random in twelve States, the number of inhabitants from 1890 to 1900 decreased seventy-seven thousand, eight hun dred and twenty-three, an average decrease of more than three thousand for each county. The road im provement in these counties was only one and five-

In the same States, twenty-five other counties where the road improvement was forty per cent during the same period were chosen for comparison and it was found that these had increased in popula-tion seven hundred and seventy-eight thousand, three hundred and eighty-three, an average of nearly thirty-two thousand in each county.

The moral is self evident. Those communitie that neglected their roads lost over seventy-seven thousand inhabitants, those that improved their roads gained over seven hundred and seventy-eight thousand. In these results, there were doubtiess thousand. In these results, there were doubtiess other factors besides highway conditions but it is clear that the latter played the determining part; for, in healthfulness, fertility and other natural advantages the two groups of counties were about equally matched. One group developed its resources by juilding good roads, the other slept over its opportunities in tolerating bad roads; and therein lay the wide difference between their fortunes. This record should be a quickening example to every county in the land. The community that own-looks or shirks its highway duties may be sure that it will decline not only in population but in wealth, in trade and industry and agriculture and in all its practical interests. On the other hand, the community that provides itself with well built, well kept roads is assured steady growth.

Where roads are poor the farmer is handicapped, the merchant is discouraged, land values decline, schools are sparsely and irregularly attended, visits among neighbors are few and far between, pulse spirit is stifled and there is no basis or incentive for co-operative effort in the upbuilding of common in-terests. Little wonder that people move away from such a county and that homeseekers and investors pass it by.

President Wilson's first annual address to Congress was notable alike for the terseness and comprehension with which he discussed those matters that now particularly engage the interest of all "who study the welfare and progress of the nation."

On the banking and currency issue, he dwelt briefly, urging the importance of concentrated enwrgy in the Senate and, at the same time, expressing confidence that a satisfactory law would soon be enacted. By every omen, his hope in this regard is justified; certainly, there is nationwide response to his assertion that the country is waiting with impalence for currency reform," as for something fundamental to its whole business life and necessary to set credit free from arbitrary and artificial restraints."

The President indicated, his purpose of addressing Congress later in the seasion with particular reference to the trust question; for the present he simply point out the need of supphementing the Sherman Anti Trust act in such a way-as to make it clearer and fairer to all concerned and "to prevent private monopoly more effectually than it has yet been prevented."

The appeal for the opening up of Alaska's resources through Government aid, for more generous and intelligent interest in agricultural problems, was pecially as regards rural credits and for workmanly fellowship between federal and State governments in solving problems of conservation, will cellst the hearty approval of all good Americans, irrespective of party alignments.

Likewise public sentiment and public judgment will accord with the President's recommendation that a law be unacted providing for primary elections throughout the country "at which the voters of the several parties may choose their nominees for the Fresidency without the intervention of nominating conventions." Party conventions should be retained, he said, "but only for the purpose of delaying and accenting the vecilit of the rormaries nating conventions." The Administration's policy toward the Philip-pines has been so clearly indicated that extended comment was unnecessary. The President left no doubt, however, that the good of the islandsurs was primarily in view, that we must move toward their independence not recklessly or sentimentally but "as steadily as the way can be cleared and the founda-tions thoughtfully and permanently laid."

The message was marked in its entirety by the same breadth and succinctness that has made each of the President's preceding additesses to Congress distinctive and statesmanly. The enthusiasm with which it was received is cheering proof of the unity of purpose that obtains between the executive and he legislative branches of our government and fore-casts a harmonious and fruitful record for the reg-ular session of Congress that has just opened.

It is no policy that will become historic and guide this nation through long decades to come; furthermore, it will serve as no other policy could the needs of the present; it will win the confidence of all thoughtful, patriotic people in our neighboring republics and will advance our highest interests throughout Central and South America.

In respect to Mexico, the Wilson policy has thus far been winnently justified. Refusal to recognize the lawless, criminal regime of Huerta has been the survest way toward peace and toward a satisfactory adjustment of Mexican problems. What may follow the fall of Huerta, which is now foregone, cannot be clearly discerned; that is a matter that must be left to separate treatment. It is certain, however, that so long as the usurper runnine in power, no constructive step toward settling Mexican troubles can be taken.






